

Building and equipment at St. Luke's Special Needs School

St. Luke's will be the first special needs school in Teso North District. The school will be designed to educate and develop the potential of children who are blind or deaf-mute, as well as children with mental or psychomotor disorders.

The school will have an enrolment of 50 children, who have already been registered within the region. Sixteen of these currently attend class in the disused kitchen at neighbouring Kakemer state school. Their two teachers, of excellent ability, are qualified in special needs teaching. A third teacher is due to be recruited by the Government in view of the school's opening (January 2014).
